In 2009, the Polish Scientific Association of Adapted Physical Activity (PTN-AAF) initiated international conferences under the common title *Theory and practice of adapted physical activity*, which have been organised ever since as biennial events. The 6th conference will be held in Biała Podlaska, organized in the friendly environment under the auspices of the Pope John Paul II State School of Higher Education in Biała Podlaska, in cooperation with PTN-AAF and the Faculty of Rehabilitation of the Józef Piłsudski University of Physical Education in Warsaw.

We would like to invite you to participate in the coming conference, which aims at presenting the latest scientific achievements and practical solutions in the field of adapted physical activity (APA).

The conference programme includes a plenary session during which invited experts from Poland and abroad are going to present their findings. It will then be followed by thematic sessions (including those run by student research interest groups), and workshops conducted by specialist practitioners.

CONFERENCE THEME

- 1. APA in school education, tourism, recreation and sport.
- 2. APA in physiotherapy, with particular focus on chronic diseases.
- 3. APA in promotion and prevention of health and therapy of older adults.
- 4. Examples of good practices in APA.
- 5. Traditional and modern forms of physical activity for people with special needs.

As part of the last topic, we would like to attract particular interest of participants in dance movement therapy, movement forms adapted to the needs of people with special needs. Dance adaptations support the process of physical and mental development, social integration, facilitate the person's learning about capabilities of own body and emotional reactions, as well as improve communication and development of relations between people. It seems to be an underestimated form of movement, which is worth promoting.

The conference participants and other persons interested in the topics of the conference will be able to take part in three workshops:

- 1. Dancing can heal: dancing in a circle, music and movement exercises, improvisation (workshop instructor: Zofia Aleszko).
- Dance movement therapy as a form of improving function of people with intellectual disabilities (workshop instructor: Tomasz Kuta).
- 3. Dancing in sensory therapy (workshop instructor: Katarzyna Rybok).

Editorial requirements: abstract up to 250 words, font: Times New Roman (12 points), margins: 2.5 cm, line spacing: 1.5.

Presentation in the form of a poster

Reports presented in the form of a poster should be legible from a distance of 1 m and should not exceed the width of 0.8 m and height of 1 m. The poster should contain the following information: name and surname of the author(s), name of the institution, title, purpose of the research, methodology used, research results and conclusions.
