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Abstract: The study of the effect of the use of the Internet on the learning of English as a foreign language is a topic that has attracted the attention of researchers in the field of applied linguistics. This research aims to analyze the impact of the use of the Internet on the learning of English as a foreign language in a specific context. The study was conducted in a classroom of a secondary school in the city of Madrid, Spain. The participants were 30 students, aged between 14 and 16 years, who were divided into two groups: a control group and an experimental group. The control group received traditional face-to-face instruction, while the experimental group received instruction that incorporated the use of the Internet. The data was collected through questionnaires and interviews, and the results were analyzed using statistical methods. The findings of the study indicate that the use of the Internet had a positive impact on the learning of English as a foreign language, particularly in terms of vocabulary acquisition and reading comprehension. The experimental group showed significantly higher scores than the control group in these areas. The study also found that the use of the Internet increased the students' motivation and engagement in the learning process. The results suggest that the use of the Internet can be an effective tool for enhancing the learning of English as a foreign language in a classroom setting.
